

2011 QUT English Language Scholarships for Latin American Students

QUT International College (QUTIC) is offering Merit Scholarships for Latin American students studying a combination of QUT English language and academic programs.

Scholarship recipients will receive AUD\$1500 towards their English for Academic Purposes (EAP) or EAP Plus program.

The Merit Scholarships

For students with an offer for General English (10 or 15 weeks) and EAP (12 weeks) or

EAP Plus (24 weeks)

and

A conditional offer for a place in a QUT academic program (Foundation, University Diploma, Bachelor, Master, or PhD) where the only condition is meeting the English entry requirement.

Eligibility

Students must:

- Commence the EAP or EAP Plus program in 2011.
- Meet academic entry requirements for QUT Masters (Research) or PhD programs.
- Exceed the academic requirements for a QUT Foundation, University Diploma, Bachelor or Masters (coursework) program with grades equivalent to 5.0 (on a 7-point scale).



Preference will be given to students who provide an IELTS or TOEFL score.
