What Things Cost in Auckland

New Zealand is not an expensive country, but it is not a very cheap one either. It is somewhere in the middle. Things are generally a bit cheaper here than in Western Europe or Japan and a bit more expensive than in many other Asian, East European and Latin American countries. Here are a few examples of what you can expect to pay for things in Auckland. All prices are in New Zealand dollars.

- An unlimited ride monthly bus/train/ferry pass (all stages) \$199
- Supermarket (per week if student is staying at WWH) \$60
- Entertainment (per week) \$30+
- Gym Membership (per month) \$85
- Fast Food lunch (fish and chips, Big Mac Combo etc.) \$6.50
- A Pizza for two \$12
- A beer in a pub \$6
- A movie \$8-15
- A recent CD \$15-\$25
- A can of coke \$1.50
- A souvenir t-shirt \$20
- A postcard bought and mailed home \$3
- A cappuccino in a cafe \$3.50
- A haircut \$12 men/\$25 women
- A daily newspaper \$1.50
- A swim at the local pool \$5.50
